Hat Incentive Deposit

Our Hat Incentive Deposit has been extended to March 23, this should provide ample time for us to catch up onboarding everyone with this new process. I apologize for the delay, most issues that have been brought to our attention have been fixed at this time. As a reminder, the hat incentive deposit is a \$35 per person deposit that anyone who pays this deposit will receive a free incentive hat for the season. (The \$35 is allocated towards final fees). Troops have the opportunity to put embroidery on the back of the hat. This will be the same embroidery for all hats. Embroidery is \$7 per hat. (This \$7 will not be allocated towards final fees).

Fee Schedule Reminder

Our fee schedule is broken up into three different parts. The first being the campsite deposit of \$500. This is often paid during the previous summer to ensure a spot for next summer.

The second deposit is the Hat Incentive Deposit (\$35/person) which is now due March 23 as noted above.

The third part of this deposit is final fees which are due 30 days in advance.
